Maintenance of GUBI chair, wood

Cleaning and maintenance

For dusting and light cleaning of the wooden surface and frame use a soft, dry cloth.

For further cleaning, use a soft cloth that is firmly wringed in clean water for gently wiping the surface, and then immediately use a dry cloth to wipe the surface again.

If more thorough cleaning is necessary, use soapsuds or washing-up liquid dissolved in water on a firmly wringed cloth. Afterwards, repeat the process with clean water as described above.

Polish with a soft cloth after wiping.

Do not use materials for maintenance that:

- Contain abrasive agents.
- Are basic, acidiferous or organic.

For the best maintenance of the product, protect it against sunlight and heat, and try to keep it away from moisture, grease and other dirt.

Furthermore, protect the surfaces against sharp objects and other that might scratch.

Maintenance of GUBI chair, HiRek

Cleaning and maintenance

Chair for inside use:

For dusting and light cleaning of the plastic surface and frame use a soft, dry cloth.

For further cleaning, use a soft cloth that is firmly wringed in clean water for gently wiping the surface, and then immediately use a dry cloth to wipe the surface again.

If more thorough cleaning is necessary, use soapsuds or washing-up liquid dissolved in water on a firmly wringed cloth. Afterwards, repeat the process with clean water as described above.

Polish with a soft cloth after wiping.

Do not use materials for maintenance that:

- Contain abrasive agents.
- Are basic, acidiferous or organic.

For the best maintenance of the product, protect it against sunlight and heat, and try to keep it away from moisture, grease and other dirt.

Furthermore, protect the surfaces against sharp objects and other that might scratch.

Chair for outdoor use:

The maintenance for outdoor use is the same as for indoor use.

The chair will probably need more frequent and thorough maintenance and cleaning, due to the outdoor conditions. Even though the chair is made for outdoor use, the product should be protected against damaging factors to maintain the quality.

Maintenance of GUBI chair, upholstered

Cleaning and maintenance

For cleaning the upholstered surface, first try to brush off the dirt gently. If this is not enough then vacuum the surface.

If further cleaning of the padding is needed, a stain remover is recommended. The cleaning has to be gentle and must always be tested on the most invisible area of the surface before the actual cleaning. Avoid blotches by gentle, circular rubbing towards the stain.

To avoid stains, quickly remove the dirt with a piece of absorbing household wipe and clean with water and colourless washing-up liquid.

Do not use the following products for the padding:

- Undiluted cleaning liquids.
- Bleach.
- Ammoniac.
- Soap for hard surfaces.

For dusting and light cleaning of the frame use a soft, dry cloth.

For further cleaning of the frame, use a soft cloth that is firmly wringed in clean water for gently wiping the surface, and then immediately use a dry cloth to wipe the surface again.

If more thorough cleaning is necessary, use soapsuds or washing-up liquid dissolved in water on a firmly wringed cloth to wipe the seat. Afterwards, repeat the process with clean water as described above.

Polish with a soft cloth after wiping.

Do not use materials for maintenance that:

- Contain abrasive agents.

If more thorough cleaning of the frame is necessary, use soapsuds or washing-up liquid dissolved in water on a firmly wringed cloth to wipe the seat. Afterwards, repeat the process with clean water as described above.
