Sister Collection

Sister is Dowel Jones first upholstered collection, designed by New York designer Tom Hancocks. Sister is a range of chairs and lounges, featuring soft, tactile upholstered pieces encapsulated in Dowel Jones signature powder coated steel. Launched in New York in 2018, the Sister pieces details have been designed as to look good for all angles, providing incredible comfort for all spaces.

Low-slung Thimble and its taller sibling, 1/5 Thimble are simple, smart, stackable stools designed to enhance contemporary settings indoors and out. The original Thimble was designed in 2012, with 2017 seeing new additions to the collection such as the Thimble Table and Double Thimble Table.

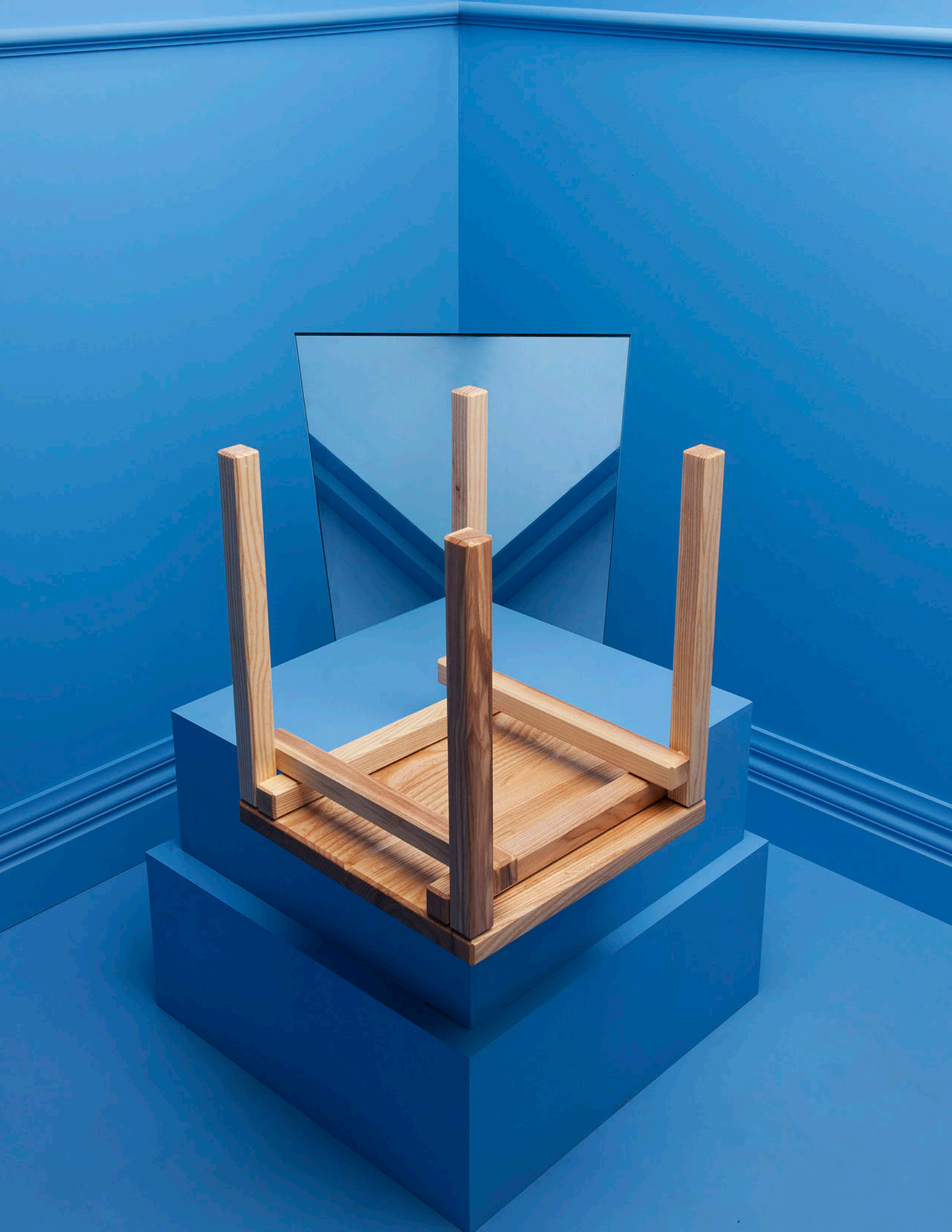

ATC Chair

ATC Chair (aptly named Another Tube Chair) is a tubular classic. Made from bent tubular steel with a solid timber seat, the large round back rest is shaped to cradle the back along with allowing it to stack in multiples. Designed with functionality and versatility in mind, both the frame and seat colours can be customised making the ATC Chair incredibly versatile for both commercial and residential interiors.

Bradley Hooper

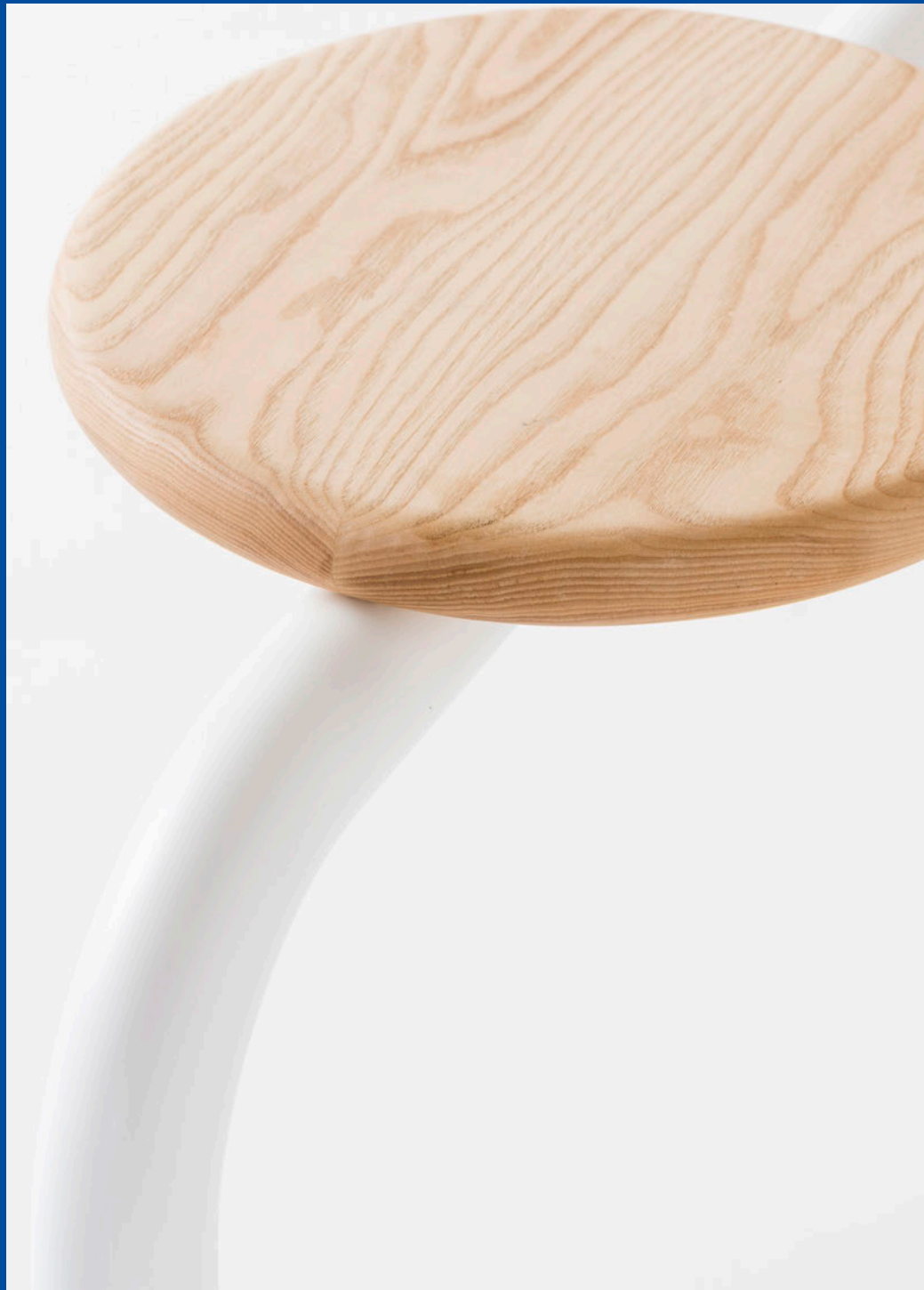
Designed and manufactured in Australia, Bradley Hooper is a range of simple stools, coffee tables and side tables. Bradley Hooper features a spun metal dish, solid American Ash, American Oak and walnut tops, complimented by cork inserts. Concentric rings in the Bradley Hooper side table hold bent wire forms to create a bottle like shape.

Sir Burly and Sir Benchaman Burly are the first releases in the Burly collection. Inspired by playground equipment and originally designed for PLAY, a solo exhibition by Dowel Jones in 2016, the Burly collection is made up of stools using thick tube and simple round solid timber tops. The Burly collections simple lines give it a strong personality.





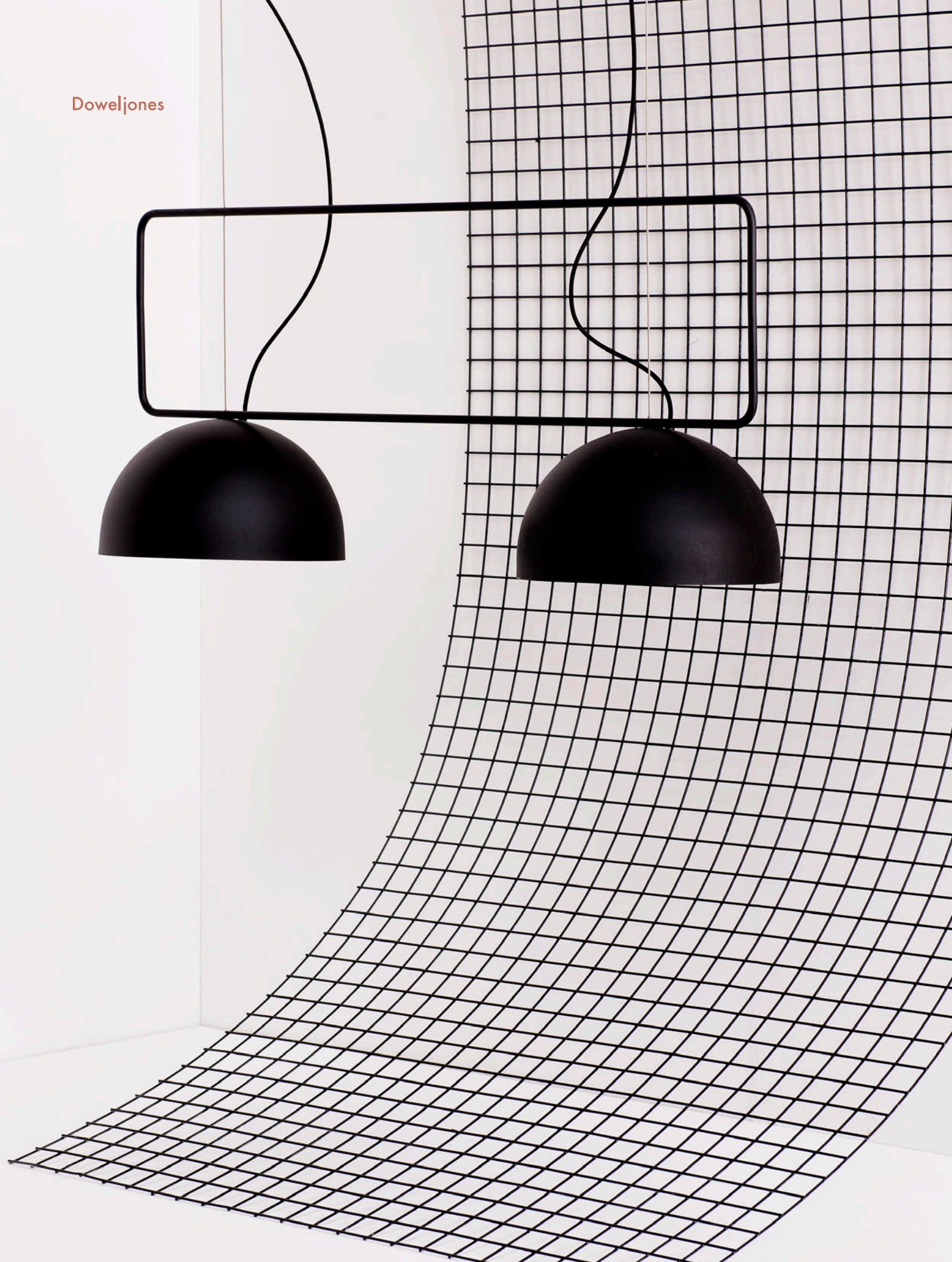
Sir Burly Low Stool - Blaze Blue, Violet, Orange X15.



Sir Burly High Stool - Pearl White.





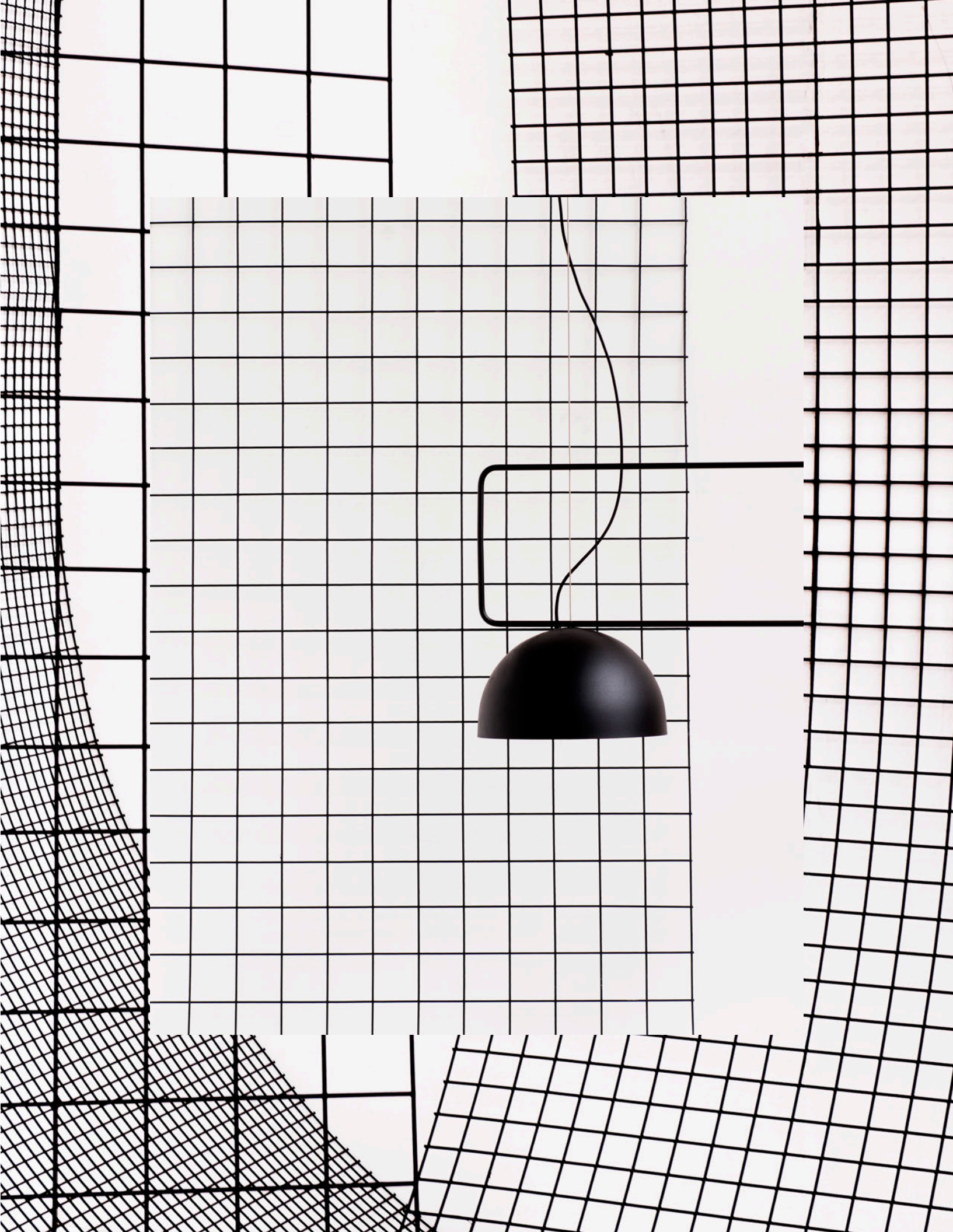
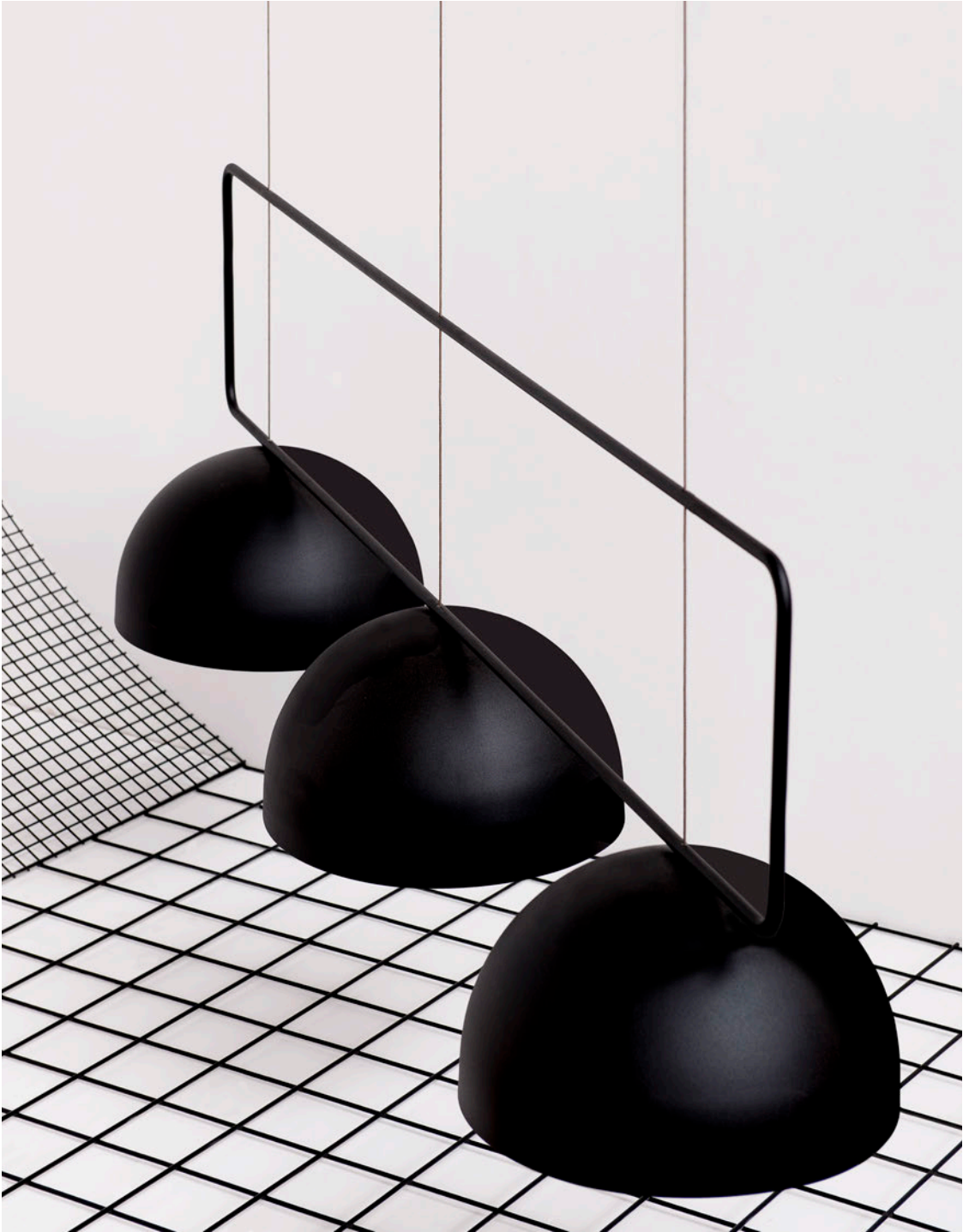


King Dome

King Dome designed for Woodmark Australia is a series of simple spun metal and rod lights available in 3 variations. Versatile in its application, King Dome focuses on silhouette and intersecting line with the thin metal structure creating grid like formations within spaces.





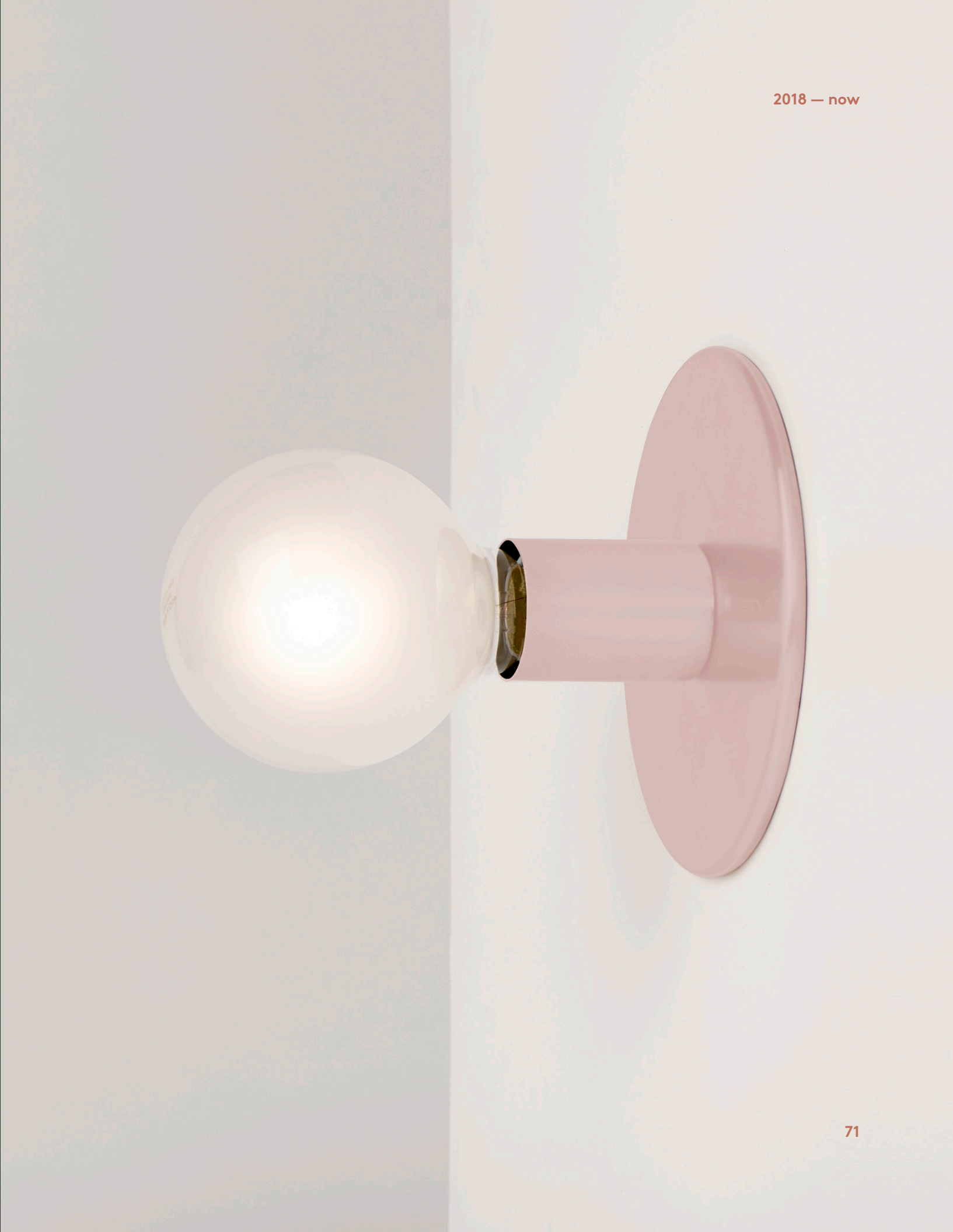




Lord Sconce

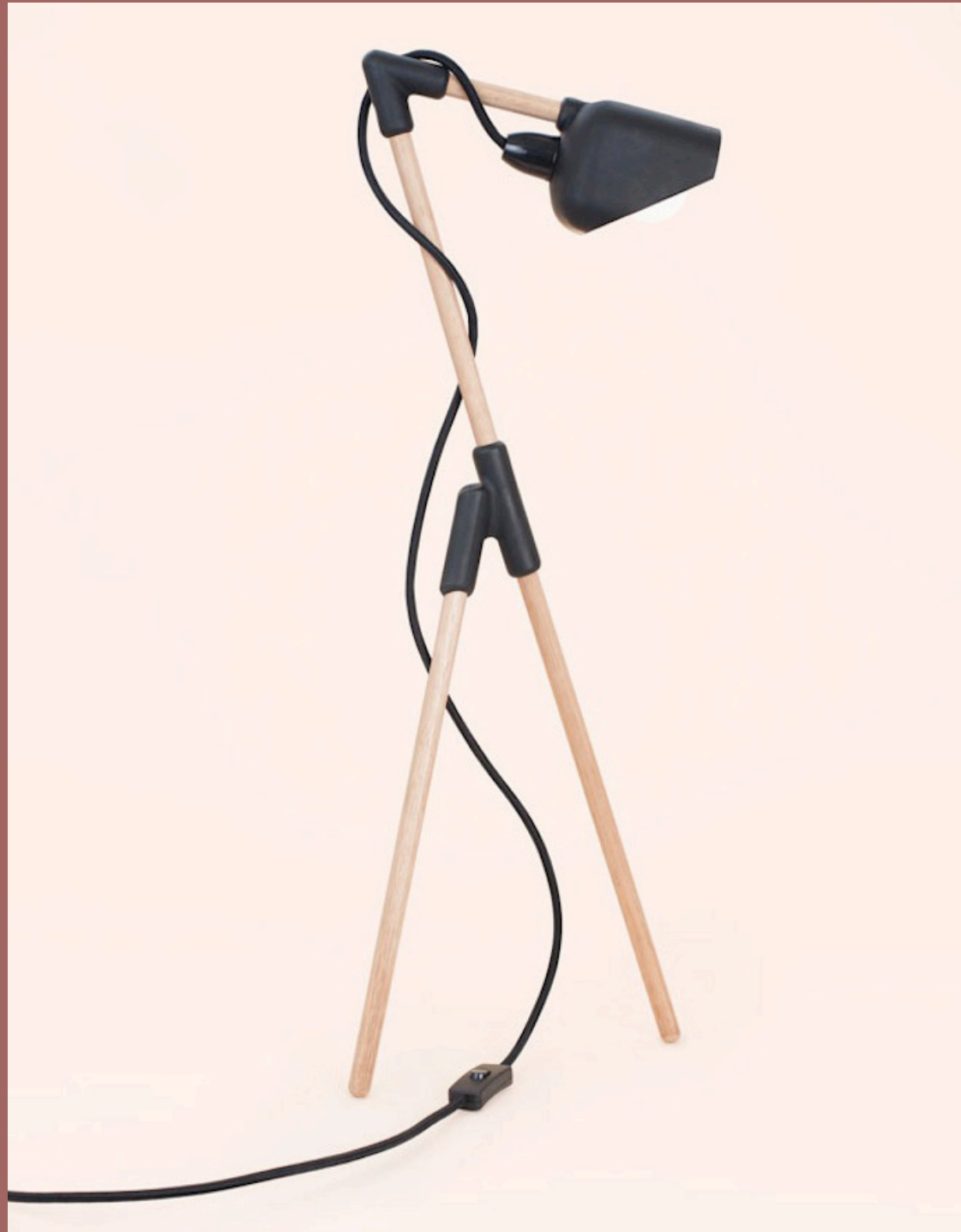
The design intention of Lord Sconce was to create a simple, seamless wall light with multiple applications. Sitting almost flush against the wall with no visible fixings, Lord Sconce can either blend into an environment with a powder coated finish, or stand out with a satin brass finish.







Lord Sconce I - Satin Brass.

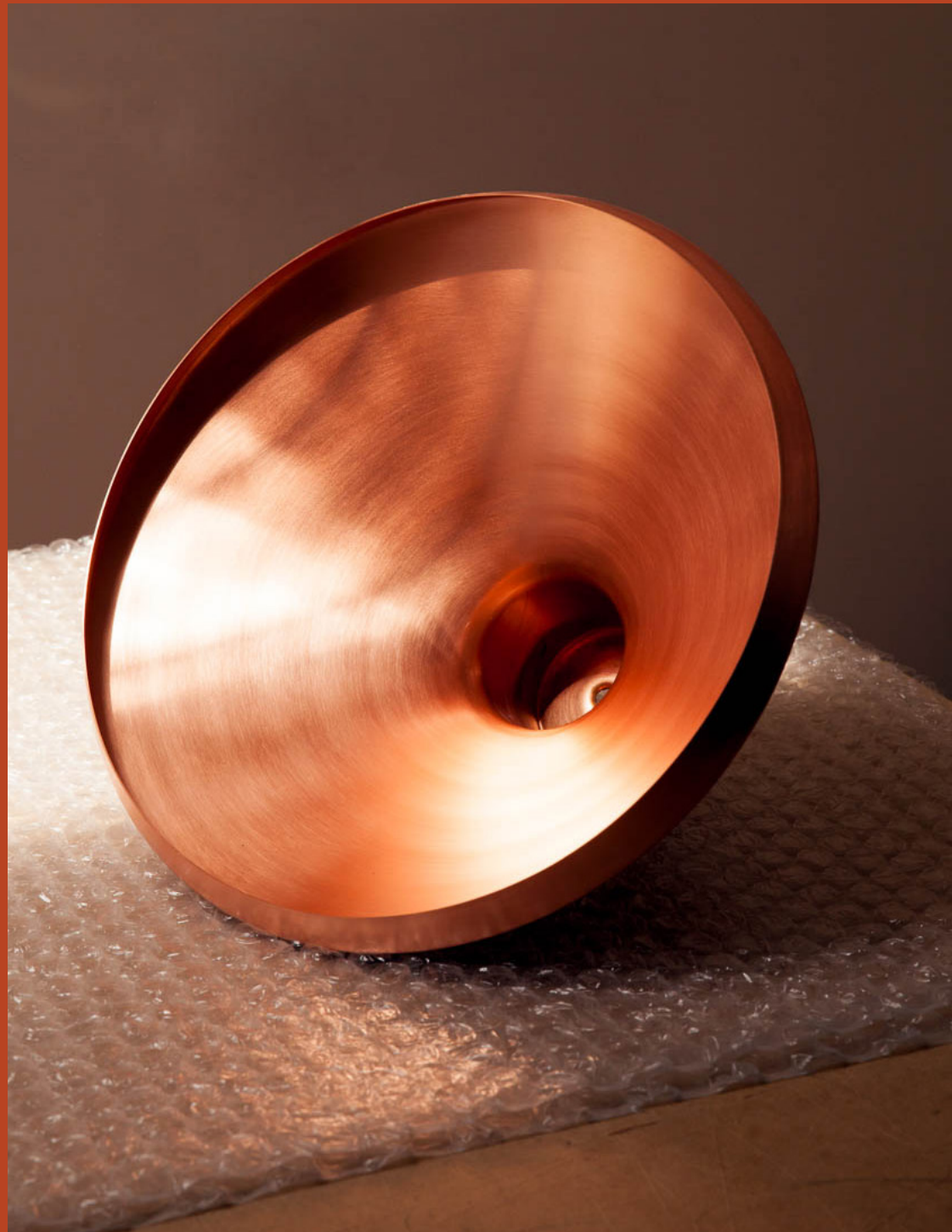


Mr Dowel Jones

Made up of rubber and timber components, Mr. Dowel Jones is a simple flat-pack lamp (desk lamp and floor lamp - desk lamp weighs 900grams). All timber components slot fit into the rubber components (no fixings) and it takes minutes to assemble.







Dr Spinner

Dr. Spinner is a simple one piece spun copper and aluminium pendant light manufactured in Melbourne available in copper and powder-coated aluminium.







Desk Life

Desk Life released in 2015 was created in reaction to the amount of off-cuts created in the production of other objects. Each product was designed to be paired alongside its companions, but is happily used alone.
