b·a·e worktables are designed for eight to twenty people, for workspaces where the collaborative is as important as the personal, and the casual valued above formality.

They are made from solid industrial oak wood with MDF tops which can be specified with either a choice of five industrial oak laminates, from light to dark or seven monochrome colours from white to black or in our range of standard melamine colours and finishes, all with a solid oak edge. The tops overhang the structure to afford generous free leg space and allow two people between each leg, with an additional two at each end either in line, or on the end of the table. The industrial aesthetic of **b·a·e worktables** can be enhanced with the option of expressing the solid oak leg through the worktop.

Each top can be specified as a single material or as a three-way split to encourage a more personal demarcation of the worktop, and – as illustrated – each of the three planks can be specified with a different choice from the oak or coloured laminate ranges or a similar mix from the range of melamines.

The **b·a·e worktables** can be specified with a linear LED task light separating the two sides of the table and positioned and dimensioned to offer seated users visual privacy at eye height, or with the circular and adjustable **Pablo LED** task light. Both lights have on/off switches.

Power and Data is available via on-top socket units or within below top power boxes accessed via lift-off circular disc lids. Which are linked with a full length, below top cable tray with site accessible central box legs for cable drops to floor boxes. As with the original **Yawi** tables, these tables are available in our standard oak finishes – light, natural, dark oak or black – and their modular construction allows them to be easily site-assembled.
